The Project

To construct a new storage facility for munitions used by the CA Air National Guard.

The Solution

The precast arch system was delivered and erected in two eight hour shift by a crew of three labors and a superintendent. The resultant was significant time savings in the contractor's schedule.

The Advantages

The design considers blast loading to control propagation in the event of an explosion inside or nearby the munitions storage igloo, while providing an alternative solution to traditional cast in place concrete for constructing complex arch structures.
